Human Dignity



Solidarity

Ethics – Students learn business ethics such including unethical practices such as sweat shops and child labour Pressure groups - Students learn about organisations that campaign for better ethical practices in businesses.



Stewardship

Non Financial aims – Students learn that some businesses have alternative aims such as sustainability.



Participation

Social Enterprise – Students work in groups to create their own 'social enterprise', thinking of a cause that they would like to support and presenting their ideas to a panel of entrepreneurs.



The Common Good

Externalities – Students learn about the affects of business and consumer activities on society.



Legislation - Students learn about customer and employee rights.

Trade unions – Students learn about our rights as employees such as working conditions.



Option for the Poor

Not for Profit organisation – Students learn about why not for profit organisations exist.
